A decedent's digital footprint may be much larger than necessary to accomplish the goal of an executor, and likely contains extraneous and deeply private information that the decedent would not want disclosed. This form will assist in establishing which categories of data, and which specifically identified accounts, the decedent wants to be disclosed.

** This form is not meant as a stand-alone mechanism by which to require a service provider to disclose the requested data, as a provider may have no means to confirm that the author of this form is, in fact, the account holder. **
