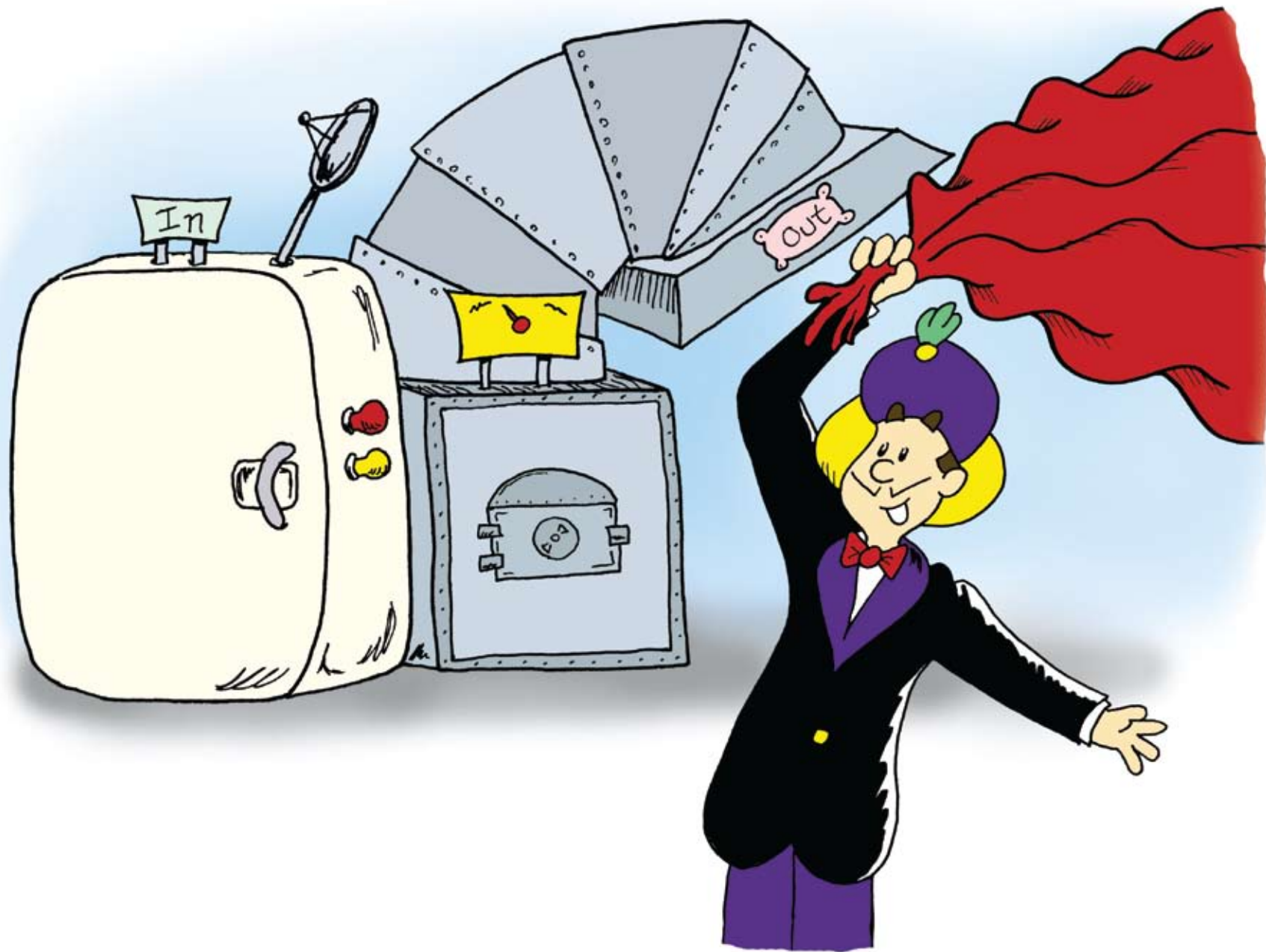


“I have here a gadget that makes all things increase,
